This February, you have a chance to support children in our community and public education. By voting "yes" on Mukilteo School District's capital bond and replacement levy measures, you'll help secure our community's investment in the future.

The Capital Bond includes:



Major Modifications and Additions - \$299.6M

Includes completing replacement of Explorer Middle & Mukilteo Elementary, Phase II of Olivia Park & Serene Lake elementary replacement, & Kamiak Gym expansion



Security Upgrades - \$6M

Expands access controls, integrated door locks to more classrooms, and perimeter enhancements for safer schools



Technology Infrastructure - \$12M

Replaces aging network cabling at 10 schools and backup network infrastructure to ensure systems continue during emergencies



Athletic and Site Improvements - \$23.4M

Improves fields at multiple schools including turf and track replacements, playgrounds, tennis court resurfacing and multi-purpose fields



Critical Facility System Updates - \$59M

Replaces aging elevators and fire alarms and provides critical improvements to HVAC, roofing, flooring, siding, windows, etc.

The Replacement Levy includes:



Staffing and services not funded by the state

While much of staffing is paid for with state funding, only "basic" costs are covered. Levies help ensure students have access to nurses, counselors, special education services and programs that are not fully funded by the state.

This levy is not a new levy. It would replace the voter-approved levy passed in 2022 which expires in 2026.
